EASY-RES is getting the European Electricity Grid ready for 100% Renewable Energy Sources

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EASY-RES (Enable Ancillary Services by Renewable Energy Sources) aims at making the EU energy grid ready for up to 100% renewables. EASY-RES is a Horizon 2020 research project developing ancillary services as a technical prerequisite for a renewable power system, which will be able to sustainably, securely and reliably deliver electricity from renewables. The project started in March 2018 and will last until mid-2021. For the joint vision of a sustainable, secure, and stable EU grid, 11 partners from six European countries (Greece, Spain, Germany, Netherlands, United Kingdom, and Slovenia) from academia and industry cooperate intensively. The project is coordinated by the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Greece and is funded by the EU with about 4.6 million Euros.
